Students should also be aware that:

- This program is offered 100% online.
- Students in this program are provided preparation for the CompTIA A+ (exams 1 and 2), Network+, and Cloud+ certification exams. Porter and Chester Institute provides vouchers to students for the first attempt at these certification exams. Fees for subsequent certification exam attempts will be at the expense of the student.
- Relocation greater than 25 miles may be necessary to locate optimal graduate employment opportunities.
- Graduates may be subject to criminal background checks or drug tests as part of the employment process. Graduates unable to pass these tests may have difficulty obtaining employment.
- Veterans Benefits cannot currently be used for this program.
