Physical Examination Acknowledgement Form

By electronically completing the acknowledgment form, I confirm the following regarding my application for enrollment in the Practical Nursing program at Porter and Chester Institute:

- Every Nursing student must submit documentation of a physical examination, which was completed within the last year, and documentation of their immunization history.
- The completed, two-page Physical Examination Form (including immunization history) should be submitted to Porter and Chester **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE**, but in no instance later than the end of the second week of the term (i.e. before the first clinical class.)
- Clinical sits may require additional immunizations (influenza, COVID, pneumonia, etc.) and it is the student's responsibility to comply when informed of the requirement, or to document a valid medical or religious exemption to the site's satisfaction. I understand that I will be required to withdraw from the program, if I am denied access to clinical sites because of unvaccinated status.
- If there are more applicants than openings in the Practical Nursing program, consideration will be given first to those applicants with a completed Physical Examination form on file.
- Students without a completed Physical Examination form on file will not be able to attend the offsite clinical classes.
- Students exceeding the clinical absence quota for any reason, including absences due to a missing Physical Examination form, **will be subject to dismissal** from the Practical Nursing program.
